Terms & Conditions for Parents & Guardians

1	Eligibility & Inclusivity	Our SATS Booster Club welcomes all children. We will provide an inclusive, supportive, and safe learning environment.
2	Commitment & Attendance	Consistent attendance is vital for your child's progress. Parents/guardians should inform us in advance if their child will be absent.
3	Timekeeping	Sessions will start and end promptly. Children must arrive on time to start each session and must leave on time at the end of each session. A late collection fee will apply for any pick-up 10 minutes or more after the end of each session without prior notice/agreement.
4	Nominal Fee & Refund Policy	A nominal fee will be necessary to cover resources and running costs. We will do all we can to keep costs down. There will be no refunds for missed sessions.
5	Key Learning Tools	We may recommend learning tools to support your child(s) progress (optional).
6	Supervision & Safety	We will supervise children during each session. Parents are responsible for their child(s) behaviour and safety before and after each session.
7	Qualified Teaching	A qualified teacher and experienced tutor will deliver each session to ensure high-quality learning.
8	Respect & Behaviour	Children must show respect to the tutor, tutor assistants and fellow students at all times. Repeated child disruption may result in removal from the program.
9	SEND Support	We do our best to accommodate children with additional needs. Please inform us of any learning, medical, or behavioural needs so we can determine if we can provide the necessary support.
